

22 SoundCloud



G-Stomper Studio (full version), G-Stomper Producer (full version), G-Stomper Rhythm, and G-Stomper VA-Beast (full version), all allow to share your created music. This means, once you've exported your tracks or loops as audio, you can share the exported audio files directly from the particular G-Stomper app.

You can share your audio files via every supported app as long as the file size does not exceed the file size limits of a particular destination. When sharing via E-Mail, it's not recommended to go higher than around 15-20mb.

In order to share an audio file with an app, this particular app must be installed on your device. E.g., if the SoundCloud app is installed on your device, you can upload your finished tracks (audio files) to SoundCloud using the share feature.

22.1 Upload Exported Audio to SoundCloud

Show up the Main Menu.

Depending on the used App, the Main Menu location and its content might be different.


G-Stomper Studio, G-Stomper Rhythm and G-Stomper VA-Beast:




G-Stomper Producer:



To upload an audio file, select the SHR tab, and then choose “Share exported Audio”.



Select the file you want to upload.



Note:

Keep in mind that the list contains only Tracks/Songs which you have already exported as Audio. So be sure to export your finished Track before you start the Upload.


Also keep in mind that mobile users usually cannot listen to high quality audio formats (24bit or higher). For SoundCloud uploads it is recommended to export your audio files with in 16bit, 44100/48000Hz, Stereo.


22.1.1 SoundCloud App installed

If the SoundCloud App is already installed on your device (and you signed in with your SoundCloud account), then the SoundCloud icon will appear in the share dialog.

Select the SoundCloud icon to show up the SoundCloud Upload page.




And finally, click the upload button to start the upload.



22.1.2 SoundCloud App not installed

If the SoundCloud icon does not appear in the share dialog, it's most likely because the SoundCloud app is not installed on your device.



In order to upload your tracks to SoundCloud you must to install the SoundCloud app from the play store.

When you finished the installation, start the Upload again.

22.2 What happened to the G-Stomper Studio Music Group on SoundCloud?

Unfortunately SoundCloud decided to completely shut down and remove Groups from their service at Monday, 22th of August 2016.

SoundCloud did not confirm the integration of an adequate replacement for groups yet.
